All carbon arrows are allowed. All arrows must be accounted for before leaving the premises.

If applicable, please ensure you have received clout instruction prior to the shoot. Instruction may not be available on the day.

Shooting

Entrants may use any GNAS Target Bow Styles except for Crossbows.

Photography In accordance with the GNAS Protection of Children and Vulnerable Adults Policy, anyone wishing to take photographs at the event must register with the Tournament Organiser on arrival at the venue.

Archer's special requirements If you have any special needs such as space for a tactile sight, wheelchair, stool or electric buggy, or space for a helper dog, or a privacy tent, etc, please indicate on the form.

Site Owner's restrictions

Smoking or Vaping is allowed on the premises but please keep away from the shooting line and other people. Dogs are to be kept under control. Cars should be brought onto the field for parking and not park in the lane. Please bag-up and take all rubbish home with you, and make sure you retrieve all your arrows from the range.


